Gifted and Talented Identification Process

A Guide to Referrals for GT Program Eligibility in Waller ISD

The Texas Education Agency describes a gifted and talented student as one "who performs at or shows the potential for performing at a remarkably high level of accomplishment when compared to others of the same age, experience, or environment and who:

- exhibits performance capability in an intellectual, creative, or artistic area;
- possesses an unusual capacity for leadership;
- or excels in a specific academic field."

Parents/Guardians should discuss appropriateness of GT testing referrals with child's teacher and/or campus Counselor.

GT Testing Process

- 1. Parent/Guardian, teachers, counselor, and administrators may refer a student for GT Testing.
- 2. Parent/Guardian must obtain, sign, and return the Parent Referral and Permission for Testing form.
- 3. Referred students are then scheduled by campus counselor for abilities testing administered at the campus during school hours on a date set by the campus.
- 4. Parents/Guardians will be notified in advance of testing dates.
- 5. Students who score within the gifted range on the test qualify for GT program services.
- 6. Students take home testing results to parents/guardians.
- 7. Parent/Guardian signs and returns permission form for student to receive GT services.
- 8. Students are scheduled into classes with GT-trained teachers.

Referral Period for CURRENTLY ENROLLED STUDENTS in Grades 1-11 Testing March 25 – April 5, 2024

- Parents/Guardians obtain the Parent Referral and Permission to Test form from the child's campus.
- Completed forms must be returned to the campus Counselor by April 5, 2024.
- Late forms will **NOT** be honored.
