I would like to thank those of you who have taken the time to complete the survey regarding the 2020 marching band season that was sent to you earlier this week. We are diligently working to prepare for the upcoming season while ensuring that the health and safety of our students, staff members, and their families remain our number one priority.

At this time, we have made the decision to delay the start of Percussion and Color Guard rehearsals until August 27<sup>th</sup>. This decision is based on the survey responses that have been received so far as well as the need for additional time to acquire necessary supplies and coordinate logistical and safety protocols to provide the safest environment possible as we begin. This will also provide more time for students and parents to complete required paperwork and physical exams prior to the beginning of rehearsals.

After Percussion and Color Guard rehearsals begin on August 27<sup>th</sup>, Brass and Woodwind rehearsals will begin on Thursday, August 30<sup>th</sup> for freshmen, new members, and student leaders with all others beginning on Monday, August 3<sup>rd</sup>. We will begin releasing detailed schedules and information regarding safety protocols for these rehearsals on Tuesday, July 21<sup>st</sup>.

Further information about the remainder of the season will be released as we receive additional guidance from TEA and UIL regarding guidelines and protocols for future rehearsals, football games, and competitions.
