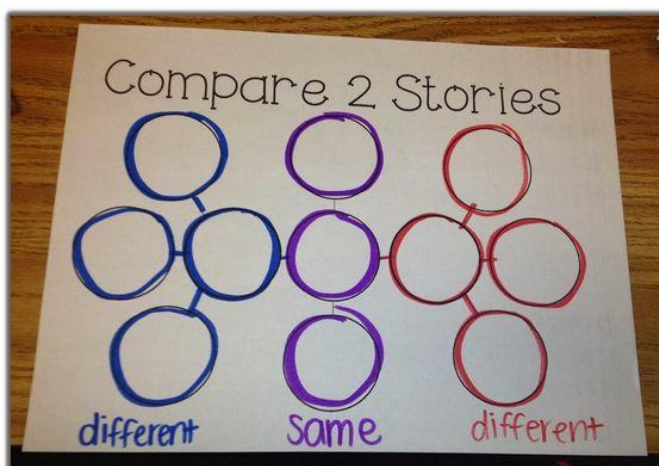
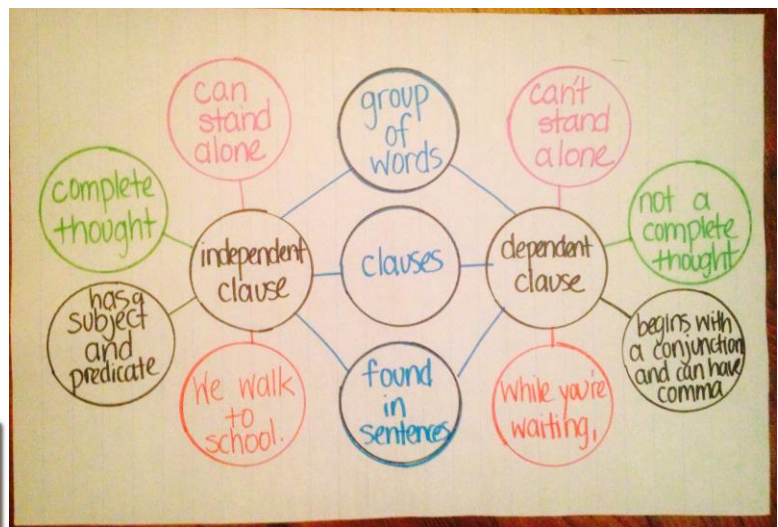
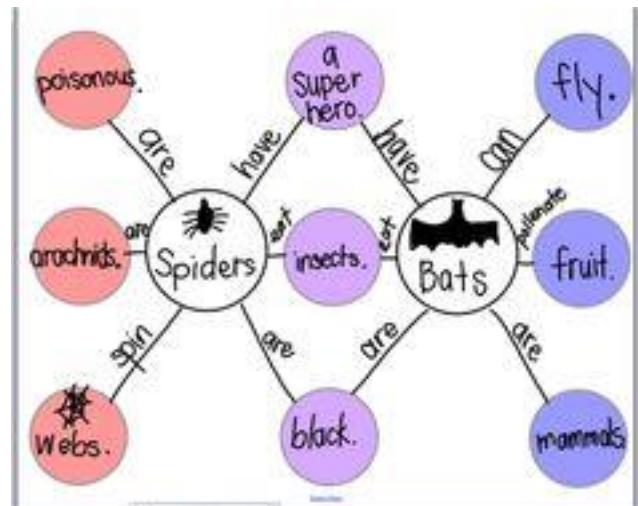


Double Bubble Maps

Double bubble maps are great tools to use when needing to compare and contrast two things. It allows the learner to categorize the qualities that the two topics share in between the two topics, while the differences are placed outside of the items.

Color-code the circles so that information is easier to obtain and the similarities and differences more noticeable.
