MISSION


New Danville provides adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities an opportunity to live enriched and purposeful lives.

Adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities will have the opportunity to live, learn, work and grow in communities of their choice.





New Danville is the visionary result of one mother's need to provide a meaningful, fulfilling life for her disabled son, and for others sharing the same needs and goals. As a result of this vision, and the passion to see it through, a group of community leaders from Montgomery County, Texas, joined her to establish Texas New Community Alliance as a charitable organization.

The vision was, and still is, the creation of a self-sustaining, integrated community where adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities, and those needing similar services, can Live, Learn, Work and Grow in an environment that upholds individual rights, dignity and respect.

From its early beginning in 2004 through today, New Danville is committed to providing life enrichment services that contribute to the social, emotional, and physical growth of each of its participants.





The activities offered during the day include classes in sewing (sewing, crochet and quilting skills), cooking, art and mosaic, sign language, animal care therapy (horses and miniature ponies), gardening and vegetable planting, music, golf cart driving, and hand-bell choir.

Our participants thrive in an environment that is rich in variety of classes and designed for their individual functioning level.

The residential program offers an independent living model for adults that can meet their basic living needs. The homes are designed to be all inclusive of utilities and security.
