Frequently Asked Questions about the Brookwood Day Program:

Q: How old do you have to be to apply for a Citizen job at Brookwood?

A: You can apply at any age. We are a postsecondary program.

Q: What is the admission criteria?

A: Our goal is to keep Citizens safe, healthy and happy. Through an interview process, Brookwood and families will determine together if we think a Citizen will be safe, healthy and happy at Brookwood.

Q: What is the cost of the day program? A: \$1,095 a month. Financial assistance is available.

Q: Is there an option for part-time work?

A: Yes, Citizen jobs are available one to five days per week, Monday through Friday.

Q: Do you offer transportation to your campus? A: Brookwood offers transportation to our main campus in Brookshire from various sites in Houston, as available. Transportation is an additional fee.
