

Health Screening Information

Waller ISD (WISD) Health Services performs age/grade appropriate health screenings as designated by the Texas Department of State Health Services. If you do not wish the district health staff to perform the screenings, you may substitute a professional examination by a licensed health care provider of your choice. Please contact your child's campus nurse for further instructions.

The results of these screenings may indicate that your child requires diagnostic evaluation beyond WISD Health Services scope of service. Campus nurses will mail home a referral letter to parents/guardians of students who require further evaluation.

Parents are urged to obtain appropriate medical care after receiving a school screening referral letter. Please return the completed referral letter form to your child's campus nurse. If you do not have insurance or cannot afford care, please contact your child's campus nurse.

• 1st-grade, 3rd-grade, 5th-grade, and 7th-grade students
